

RESOLUTION NO. 10-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE MARIANA RANCHOS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AMENDING THE CONFLICT
OF INTEREST CODE AND REPEALING RESOLUTION 99-5

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act, Government Code §81000, et seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 California Code of Regulations §18730, which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code which may be incorporated by reference and may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission after public notice and hearings to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Code by Reference

The Political Reform Act (Government Code §81000 et seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation (1 California Code of Regulations §18703) which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which may be incorporated by reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing, it may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act.

Therefore, the terms of 2 California Codes of Regulations §18730, and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, are hereby incorporated by reference. This regulation and the attached Appendices designating officials and employees and establishing disclosure categories shall constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the Mariana Ranchos County Water District.

Section 2. Place of Filing

Designated employees shall file statements of economic interests with the Secretary of the Board of Directors. Upon receipt of the statements of the Board of Directors, the Secretary of the Board shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of the statements to the County of San Bernardino. The District will retain statements for all other designated employees.

Section 3. Violations

This Code has the force and effect of law. Designated employees violating any provision of this Code are subject to the administrative, criminal, and civil sanction provided in the Political Reform Act, Government Code §81000 through §91014. In addition, a decision in relation to which a violation of the disqualification provisions of this Code or of Government Code §87100 or §87450 has occurred, may be set aside as void pursuant to Government Code §91003.


Section 4. Repeal of Resolution
